Note to Station Leader

Any notes to pass to your station assistants. Remember every sled must have the same experience every time for it to be fair in scoring

<u>Scoring</u>

Example: you will be scored by shortest time as a sled. The first sled to boil water in the shortest time, etc.



(10) IO foot lengths of rope (that's right - 10)



- Pad of Paper and Pencils (and/or pens)
- Compass (at least one the more the merrier)
 - Matches, Dry Tinder, and Kindling
 - Lunches and snacks (you be the judge)



Water bottles / Canteens (at least one quart per Scout) + 1 gallon of water



- Large Trash Bag (All trash must be carried out)
- Tools for repairs (a multi-tool is acceptable)



- Proper Clothing weather appropriate (NO SNEAKERS !!!)
- Extra set of Dry Clothing Be Prepared!
