\*Each of our 3 Winter cabins have wood or coal fired heat stoves and cook stoves (wood not provided- coal available for \$6.00 per 50lb. Bag) One bag will usually last one day and night.

\*\*Flush toilets (where applicable) are open from April to October weather permitting. Showers are also available during this time (upon request) for all sites noted above to have flush toilets.

Note; Most sites have fire pits. Only approved above ground fire containers can be used in sites where open fires are allowed. Extra ½ barrels are also available. Although fires are allowed year round @ Cachalot, the Ranger reserves the right to ban all fires if conditions are hazardous.
