TENT SITES						
<i>Lower Camp</i>

<i>Upper Camp</i>

TRAINING LODGE

PARADE FIELDS

Lower Parade field is approximately 3/4 acre of fully open area for opening/closing ceremonies and activities. Flagpoles have a natural pool in background and brook on right side. Can be accessed from bridges on right and through front parking lot. A good meeting point for large training groups and large troops.

Upper Parade Field is extremely large and sloping to a vast 1 3/4 acres. It can be accessed from the road or through the walking trails that lead from the lower parade field. The opportunities are vast to what can be done on this field. Many tents sites surround the field along with the upper amphitheatre.

Bean Hole Field is relatively small compared to other fields but has its opportunities. Approximately 1/2 acre with Rotary shelter to its right side. Flat field can be used for many troop and District events.

AMPHITHEATRES

Lower amphitheatre is located near the tent sites and can hold a large group of scouts and leaders. Area has seats and small fireplace for ceremonies and activities. Upper amphitheatre is large area with seats and raised stage with stone fireplaces on both sides of the stage. Located across the Upper Parade field and the Bean Hole Field. A great place for evening activities and fun.

CEREMONY BRIDGE

Bridge near front parking lot leads to Simmonds shelter for tables and fireplace. Plenty of space on both sides for Units to use for advancement ceremonies and Webelos Crossovers.

WALKING TRAILS

Approximately 2-3 miles of walking trails around camp. Well marked and easy to follow. A good trip on the trails will show the many different types of trees and shrubs at the camp. Another great opportunity to complete advancement requirements.

CEREMONY RIDGE

Located in the upper camp, nestled back along the trails is a great spot for night time ceremonies. Rock backdrop gives the best use of the camp natural settings for your advancement or activity ceremonies.

TRADING POST

Small assortment of treats and patches. Open only on weekends with Campmasters on duty.

SHOPPING

Stop N Shop located approximately 1 mile from camp on RT 5. Other markets within this area. The RI Mall, Warwick Mall, Home Depot, Sports Authority, Dick's Sporting Goods, Shaw's and many other outlets located on RT 2 accessed from RT 295 1 1/2 miles from Camp.

RESTAURANTS

Approx 1 mile left out of Camp you will find a large array of good restaurants and fast food to include Dunkin Donuts, Wendy's, McDonalds and good sandwich shops. A couple of good Chinese restaurants are available. A short hop onto Rt 295 to Rt 2 will give you approximately 15 different restaurants of your choice in many ethnic styles. Also, is a Hometown Buffet located on RT 2 next to the Target at very good prices. The choices are endless.

HOSPITALS

Hasbro Children's Hospital approx 5 miles and Kent County Hospital approx 8 miles from Camp
