- Around the Flagpole we will dedicate several "cornerstone" gifts of \$100,000 or more (either estate planned or outright)
- Inside the flagpole area will be an opportunity for gifts of \$25,000 or more

- SHELTER PROJECT FUND: Provides funding for the construction of a new shelter on Curtis Tract to be used year-round


