

2021 Klondike Derby Guidelines

(subject to change)

- Masks required everywhere during the event, no exceptions
- Social distancing-
 - 6 feet within groups
 - o 25 feet between groups
 - 14 feet for anyone interacting with more than one group
- Units responsible for providing complete roster, and screening scouts prior to check-in. Council will provide updated screening tools prior to the event.
- Group sizes no larger than 25
- All participants must be pre-registered, no walk-ins
- Indoor spaces (except bathrooms) off limits
- Extra bathrooms will be provided, and cleaned throughout the day
- No overnight cabin use
- No overnight camping (subject to change based on state curfews)
- Scouts/units responsible for providing their own lunch
- Limit shared equipment. All shared equipment must be sanitized between each use
