Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to earn First-Class rank.


Along with Scoutmaster Specific this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in the Scouts BSA in order to be considered trained.

Recharter is Here!


The rechartering process is your unit's opportunity to clean up its roster, renew membership, and ensure insurance coverage.


